PRE-ANESTHETIC BLOOD TESTING

Before putting your pet under anesthesia, a physical exam will be performed. As part of the pre-surgical examination, we offer pre-anesthetic blood work for a cost (see below).

The health and safety of your pet is of our utmost concern. We strongly recommend pre-anesthetic blood work on all of our surgery patients to screen for any underlying conditions that may complicate anesthesia. Routine blood work is also an excellent tool that may lead to early diagnosis of disease.

Chem 10 Panel- alerts doctors to the presence of dehydration, diabetes, liver and kidney disease

CBC & Chem 10 Blood Panel- all of the same information as the above plus information regarding anemia, infection, inflammation, immune-mediated diseases, certain cancers and problems with blood clotting.

CBC & Chem 17- most complete panel as it contains all of the information as the CBC & Chem 10 PLUS information regarding your pet's electrolyte status and the functional ability from their liver to break down the anesthetic drugs.

OPERATION SPAY OUR STRAYS (SOS)

Operation Spay our Strays (SOS) is designed for wild or untamed cats living outdoors. **This service includes the spay/neuter surgery, rabies vaccine and ear tipping(not optional).** The cat's ear will be tipped for identification purposes having gone through the SOS program. If a client opts not to have this procedure performed, the **regular** fees for spaying/neutering will apply. **EACH CAT MUST BE IN A HUMANE BOX TRAP AND THE TRAP MUST BE COVERED FOR THE SAFETY AND THE COMFORT OF THE CAT.** Per Cat Fee-\$15.00
