



York County SPCA Equine Adoption Process

For information regarding Horse Adoption from the York County SPCA, please email Anne Wagner, annekwagner@gmail.com – and request an adoption application. The application is also available on our website. To start the adoption process, fill out the application and mail it to The York County SPCA, 3159 Susquehanna Trail North, York, PA 17406. If you are interested in a certain horse, fill in the horse's name.

When the application is returned and approved, the adoption coordinator will meet personally, or speak by phone, to the applicant to make sure we have a suitable horse/rider combination. We will then do a home farm visit. After the visit, the applicant can meet the horse or horses. All the adoptable horses from the York County SPCA can be seen on [PET FINDER.com](http://PETFINDER.com).

If someone is interested in one of the present young horses and the above process is completed, we will continue working (training, riding) with the animal until it is ready to go.

The purpose of this entire process is that we want the horse to have a long term home with a happy, satisfied owner. We will talk to anyone who is sincerely interested.

There is an adoption fee for each horse. The fee ranges from \$500 to \$800, depending on the horse's age, ability, and adoptability. Companion, or light riding horses have a reduced fee of \$200.
